




Reading

This is a programme that helps the children to match the sounds to letters, to read words and to write the letters. These are the cards we use in school when the children learn a new sound.



Reading


One of the most important parts of the programme is the pronunciation of the letters. It is really important that the children say the sounds correctly as this will help them in their reading and spelling.






Read 5 times and get a stamp from your teacher.
