Must...	Spellings	Spellings will be tested every Friday and new spellings given.
	Reading	Read for at least 5 minutes daily and update your reading record-signed by an adult.
	Times tables	Practise your times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars at least 5 minutes per day.
Would be good if...	Maths	Can you find examples of fractions in your own home such as cutting a cake into equal slices? Take photos and label the fractions on seesaw.
	English	Can you write an adventure story for the creature you created in Summer 1 (based on Mr Munroe from Ottoline and the Yellow Cat)? Think about the features of a story before you begin.
	Science	Can you design a reflective book bag using your knowledge of light and reflection to keep children safe walking to school in the winter months?
Would be great if...	Art	Can you create a piece of art including some Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs?
	DT	Can you practice your sewing skills? See if you can remember the running stitch taught in year 1. You could even challenge yourself to learn the cross stitch.
