#### Attendance Letter

Beech Hill School is committed to ensuring that children receive an education that they are entitled to. In order to make this happen, we have exceptionally high standards when it comes to attendance and punctuality and fully expect parents/carers to support the school in making sure that all children arrive in school every day and on time.

Through the academic year, we acknowledge children's high and improving attendance in a variety of ways. Children are celebrated and rewarded through assemblies, individual and whole class certificates, house points, treats and trips.

If your child is unwell, please contact the school office before 9am on 01422 345004 providing a reason for absence. If we do not hear from you, we will send a text message requesting you contact us by telephone or text message. Please note that it is essential you contact the school on the first day and every subsequent day of absence. Failure to do so will result in a home-visit by the school Attendance Officer or welfare check by the Police.

The statutory duty for attendance lies with the Local Authority. In our most recent review, the Education Welfare Officer was complimentary of our day to day procedures on tackling attendance. However, similar to many other local schools, 'term time holidays' were greatly impacting on our attendance figures and this needs to be addressed.

Our Attendance policy very clearly states that the school will not approve any 'leave of absence' **above 10 days** even for exceptional circumstances. If you take leave during term time, this will be unauthorised and is automatically referred to the Local Authority (LA). The Local Authority will then look to either fine or prosecute and the school will not get involved after this point. Please note the DfE has recently put stricter guidance in place regarding attendance and the LA will now prosecute parents which could result in court costs and fines of up to £2500.

To avoid these fines and prosecutions, please ensure you do not take any leave of absence during term time. There are sufficient opportunities for family holidays and trips abroad to be taken during the school holidays. So that we are able to support you, please come and discuss any potential absences with our Attendance Officer, Mrs Farhat.
