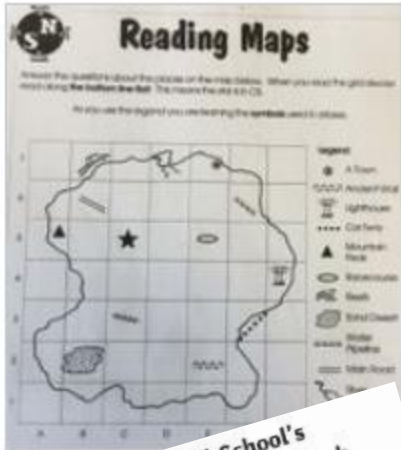


Geography Home Learning
