Choose one or more fun activities to expand your cultural knowledge of France and French-speaking countries. Make sure that you post pictures of them on Seesaw by 3pm on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> October.

1. Film yourself speaking in French; Counting, saying hello, goodbye, singing a song, etc.

2. Learn about famous French artists. Can you try to create some of your own art work in a similar style.

Take a picture and post to Seesaw. write a few comments about your experience.

3. Dress up in Red, White and Blue with a French mystery picture /item of your choice.

Take a photo and write a few lines about it on Seesaw.

4. Draw something from French History and post a picture of it.



5. Visit a famous French football team's stadium or another well known place on Google Earth or Digimaps.

Draw what you see and post it on Seesaw.

6. Eat some French food.

Take a photo and write a few lines about it on Seesaw.



7. Make a poster that shows the names of different family members in French.

Take a photo and post to Seesaw.



8. Dress up as a French fictional Francophone character (Le Petit Prince, Tintin, Astérix, a fairy tale character from one of Charles Perrault's Mother Goose Tales <http://www.perraultfairytales.com/en/bio>) or a significant person in French history (Napoleon Bonaparte, Marie Antoinette, Coco Chanel, Saint Bernadette, Zinedine Zidane, Joan of Arc, Claude Monet, Claude Debussy,...). Post your picture to Seesaw

9. Use plastic straws, lego or anything available to create a model of the Eiffel Tower or another well known landmark.

Take a photo of your famous French landmark and post to Seesaw.
