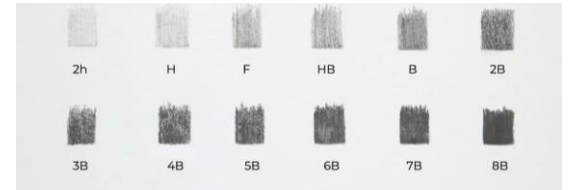

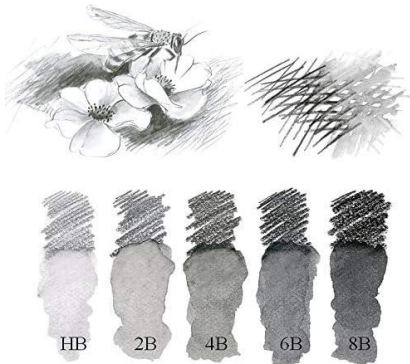


Use your hands and fingers as tools to blend soft pastel or charcoal
