The unit also teaches multiples of ten. up to 100, and children reinforce and extend their use of instructions. The purpose of this unit is to teach children the names of some animals. They will also learn to tell the time.

Quel temps fait-il? (What's the weather like?)

The purpose of this unit is to teach more phrases to describe the weather and talk about the temperature. Children will also learn to describe the clothes they need to wear in particular weather conditions.
